

VERY REV. DEAN LYNCH.

Cork Born Priest's Death In Australia

While returning to minister at Bega, Australia, following a twelve months stay in this country, the death has taken place at a private hospital in Sydney, of the Very Rev. Dean Thomas Lynch, P.P., V.F.

The unexpected news yesterday by cable announcing the Dean's death, came as a great shock to the Rev. Bro. M. P. Lynch, Kilrush, and to Sean Lynch, Knockadea, Mitchelstown, his brothers; to Mrs. P. Muilins, Anglesboro' and to his relatives and many friends in the Mitchelstown district of which he was a native.

Dean Lynch was ordained at Thurles in 1922, and later in that year went to minister in the Australian Mission, where he remained up to his death.

He was a brother of the late Liam Lynch, Chief of Staff, I.R.A.

Requiem High Mass will be offered up for the repose of his soul in Ballylanders Parish Church on Saturday next at 10 o'clock.
